### TASTING NOTES

Pale pink in color, and with notes of strawberry and rose petals on the nose. On the palate, this is a dry, south of France or Bandol style Rosé that offers a pirouette of succulent strawberry, raspberry, and cherry flavors. The finish is long and mouthwatering, echoing the aromatic entry and inviting another sip.

### FOOD PAIRINGS

Enjoy paired with herbaceous salads, creamy cheeses, and grilled salmon.

### VINEYARD & PRODUCTION

This Rosé is a traditional field blend of six varietals, all co-fermented from a 110-year-old dry farmed vineyard in the Dry Creek Valley. Produced via saignée after a six-hour cold soak and then followed by a thirty-three-day cold fermentation in stainless steel tanks.
